

Hi **Sara**,

Thanks so much for reaching out, I'd be delighted to help **Ashley** in any way that I can.

I'm not sure how much you know about what I do so I'll share just a bit, then you can call or write with any questions.

1. It is 100% free. I do this in service to the Lord
2. It all begins with a 90 minute meeting – preferably in-person, but I can do it via Zoom or phone call (if a student is under 18 I ask that at least one parent be at the meeting and copied on all correspondence)

The meeting is very light and upbeat. I just ask a bunch of questions to get to know as much as I can about the student.

Afterwards I ask the student to complete 3 online personality tests (takes 90 minutes total).

Then, after I receive the completed forms I will send a report, typically within 3 days.

The report includes careers that “fit” the student, typically 10 to 16, along with LOTS of information about each. You can see a sample report here: [STUDENT – Student Report](#)

Although the student may stop at any time it is my hope that this is just the beginning of the journey because ideally the student will review the careers (especially the first paragraph “Greg’s Comment” which explains why I feel the job is a great fit for the particular student) and find one or two he or she would like to learn more about. THAT is when the process really becomes valuable because I can:

- Find specific information about the job
- Try to obtain job-shadow opportunities
- Put her in touch with someone who works, or has worked in that career
- Identify training options including costs, scholarships, etc
- Put together a roadmap on how to get from where he or she is today, to how to apply for a job in that career

Also, even though I have a standard process I treat each student as an individual and tailor my services, and the reports to meet the needs of the student, so I can do FAR more than what is listed above.

Plus, this service works equally well for college-bound, skilled trades, healthcare professions, and more. Also, the student may come back as many times as the student requests, even months or years later.

Just a little about me:

- I'm a retired Electrical Engineer (34 yrs at Cat) with a BSEE and MSEE
- I've been married to Jill for 40 years
- We've been members of Grace Pres for 30+ years
- We have 3 grown children and 3 (soon to be 4) grandchildren
